### How to Begin

Obtain a bachelor's degree in any field and earn a master's degree or graduate certification in Vision Rehabilitation Therapy

### Where CVRTs may work

- Rehabilitation centers or schools
- State agencies
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs
- In the homes of individuals
- Assisted living or nursing home facilities

### What might a CVRT do?

- Teach methods for how to use any household **appliance**
- Provide a young professional with methods for **selecting outfits** for work
- Introduce labeling methods using **braille** or **devices with auditory output**
- Use customer service for **independent shopping** at a local grocery store
- Instruct in methods to **identify, organize, and label** medications
- Show an older adult with low vision how to **send a text** to a loved one
- Demonstrate **magnification options** for reading instructions or directions
- Teach methods to **tactually distinguish** between two cleaning products
